The Finance and Operations Management Department of the Isenberg School of Management at the University of Massachusetts Amherst invites applications for two tenure-track faculty positions at the Assistant Professor level, to start in September 2008. The department has an undergraduate program in Operations Management and coordinates the PhD track in Management Science of the doctoral program in Business Administration. Faculty are also involved in teaching at the MBA level. Candidates are required to have a Ph.D. in management science, operations management, or operations research (or related discipline), are expected to effectively teach courses in the areas of operations management and management science at both the undergraduate and graduate levels, and are expected to conduct high caliber research and publish in reputable journals. One of the two positions is in the area of supply chain management, with specific expertise in supply chain design and an emphasis on how new technologies transform processes, businesses and markets.

The University of Massachusetts Amherst is a vibrant and growing institution, committed to the vigorous enhancement of its stature as a leading public research university. The campus is a member of the Five College Consortium and collaborates with Amherst, Hampshire, Mount Holyoke and Smith Colleges on many initiatives and projects.
