### Requirements To Graduate from UMass Amherst:

1. A minimum of 120 credits, at least 45 of which must be earned in “residence”. For this purpose, residence credits are defined as being credits earned for work done while registered on the Amherst campus of the University of Massachusetts.
2. A cumulative average of at least 2.0 overall and in the major.
3. Completion of all General Education Requirements:
  - Writing – 2 levels: College Writing (CW); Junior Year Writing (determined by major department)
  - Social World – 6 courses, with at least two having a Social and Cultural Diversity
    - One course in literature (AL)
    - One course in arts/liberal arts (AT) or a second course in literature (AL)
    - One course in historical studies (HS)
    - Two courses in social & behavioral sciences (SB)
    - One additional course in any area within the Social World (AL, AT, HS, Or SB) or an interdisciplinary course (I)
  - Diversity: two courses (G, U)
  - Biological and Physical World: three courses
    - one biological science (BS)
    - one physical science
    - the third course can be either a biological or physical science
  - Basic Math Skills (R1)
  - Analytic Reasoning (R2)
    - Students will not receive General Education credit for courses taken Pass/Fail
4. Completion of an approved major.
5. Completion of all college/school requirements
