Abstract: We analyze the presence of women on the board of directors and the subsequent implementation of gender policies. We base our analysis on a sample of 182 companies listed on the Milan Stock Exchange from 2010-2015. Results show that greater representation of women on the board is positively associated with the application and disclosure of gender policies. Moreover, we contribute to the literature on social identity theory (Tajfel and Turner, 1979), which predicts the behaviors of members who belong to the same group influence the decision-making process. Our findings show that both women in leadership roles and gender diversity on the board of directors play an important role in corporate governance. Thus, our study has practical implication for both managers and policy makers.
