DETAILS & ELIGIBILITY

Program Includes:

- Admission to the McCormack graduate sport management program
- A graduate assistantship that covers tuition and fees
- Opportunity to attend events hosted by the McLendon Foundation and NACDA
- Access to the McLendon Foundation, its partners and the McLendon Leadership Initiative

Scholars Award Eligibility:

- Must be an ethnic minority
- Undergraduate GPA of at least 3.2

Application Process:

- 1. Pre-Application: Complete the <u>application</u> on McLendon's website and indicate interest in the McCormack Scholarship.
- 2. Submit application on <u>UMass' website</u> by Feb 1
- 3. On-campus interview: Top candidates will be invited to an on-campus interview to determine admission

The graduate programs meet in person. There is no fully virtual program offered at this time.
